What we worked on last week:

- We finalized planning and staffing to open in Hybrid Model this week. It's a step in the right direction!

What's next:

- Finalizing RSVL Academy implementation. The exclusive online program is intended for students or families who have health concerns related to COVID-19.
- Our comprehensive schools intend to open in a five day model on January 5, 2021, the first day of the second semester, as local health conditions allow.

Challenges ahead:
