New updates

- With updated CDPH guidance for Outdoor and Indoor Youth Sports, more RJUHSD sports have been given the green light to resume competition. Some sports, like football and water polo, were moved to the red COVID-19 tier and given permission to play based on positive case rates and weekly testing of athletes and coaches. The first football games are scheduled to be played March 12 and schools will have a five or six game season. For further information regarding the updated guidance and specific sport schedules, see your school's athletic director.

COVID-19 compliance updates:

- We anticipate a ruling from CDPH regarding our Safety Review request the week of March 8, 2021. This will determine our ability to stay in a modified 5-days per week schedule. We will inform the community as soon as CDPH provides their decision.

Zoom vs. in-person learning:

- Our support services remain available to all of our students whether it's on-campus, RSVLA or on Zoom. Mental health, overall wellness and human connection is more important to us than ever before.
- We will continue reaching out to support your well-being, but please do not hesitate to reach out to us. We are here for you.

Testing + vaccine updates:

- Vaccinations are being offered to those 65+, and those in education, childcare emergency services and food + agriculture.
