Dear Parent/Guardian,

We would like to thank all of you who participated in the FJUHSD Parent Survey last month. The District continues to monitor guidelines from the California Department of Education, the OC Health Care Agency, and other informed organizations daily. On June 18, 2020, a school reopening taskforce convened to review relevant data (including that from the parent survey) and to make recommendations for back-to-school and reopening plans.

As you learned from the email sent to you by District Superintendent Dr. Scambray, on Monday, June 29, 2020, the FJUHSD Board of Trustees granted tentative approval of the Hybrid Schedule for the 2020/21 reopening of school. While current state health and safety guidelines do not allow us to welcome all students back to school at the same time, this hybrid schedule provides students with two in-person, on-site instructional days with their teachers (with a limited number of other students in specially prepared learning environments), two instructional days in a “Virtual Classroom” from home, and one distance learning day each week (if the student is in Cohort A or Cohort B).

In addition, for parents/guardians who may not feel comfortable having their student return to the physical classroom and school site, the tentatively-adopted schedule provides an option for students to access the instructional lessons from home through the Virtual Classroom four days a week and distance learning one day a week (Cohort C).

Parents who opt for Cohort A or B do not need to make a selection on the delivery of instruction in any way. Cohort A and B are the default placement for all students. See the next paragraph and click the link **ONLY** if you want your child to stay home and attend the Virtual Classroom from home 100% of the time in Cohort C. **If you do not respond to this survey by July 17, 2020 your student will be placed in Cohort A or B.**

If you would like your student to be included in Cohort C, the group who will attend school in the Virtual Classroom and will not physically attend school for instruction in any way, [click here](#). In order for your student to be placed in Cohort C, you must let us know on or before Friday, July 17, 2020. Parents/guardians who choose Cohort C at the start of the school year for their student, and later request to join Cohort A or B will not be guaranteed the same period or teacher(s) because of physical space availability and may need to remain in Cohort C for an extended period of time during the semester.
