At Roynon, we are currently preparing for the start of the school year. Our preparation will ensure our readiness to implement a comprehensive and robust distance learning plan that will deliver the high-quality education that is the hallmark of Bonita Unified. Regardless of where the learning is happening, please know that classes will have high levels of accountability for students with rigorous curriculum.

We are in the process of currently developing a schedule of learning. In addition, we are excited to announce that we have acquired a new learning platform, Canvas, for all BUSD teachers, students, and families to utilize for the 2020-21 school year. More information will be forthcoming regarding the use of this platform for students AND parents/caregivers.



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Throughout the summer, many teachers have been participating in professional development on our district-wide learning management system (Canvas) and developing strategies for a comprehensive and robust curriculum delivered virtually.

Your InfoSnap code will be mailed to your home address in late July/early August.

The Bonita Unified School District takes part in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs. Eligible students may receive meals free of charge or at a reduced price. You or your children do not have to be a U.S. citizen to qualify for free or reduced-price meals. **Free and Reduced Lunch Applications for the 2020-21 school year can now be completed online here:** [MealApps.Bonita.k12.ca.us](http://MealApps.Bonita.k12.ca.us). Please note, all families must complete this application every year, even if you were part of the program last year. I highly recommend that each family consider applying for Free & Reduced, even if you think there is a chance you will not qualify. Our school's Title 1 compensation is directly related to our free & reduced applications. All of our students at Roynon benefit from our Title 1 designation, regardless of status.
